### Quantify and manage spatial variation on farm, David Clarke

Using long term data sets, with soil and crop monitoring from the Morley SAMS project, we begin to disentangle the drivers of on-farm spatial variation. Additional work from AHDB Strategic Cereal Farm East demonstrates how this can aid long-term on-farm management decisions.



### Measuring to develop measures, Joe Martlew

Joe Martlew presents the final findings from his now completed research into diagnosing and treating subsoil compaction, from his TMAF-supported PhD 'Quantifying and alleviating deep-seated compaction in arable soils'.
